Evaluation:

1. Summary of the students' course evaluation

Total number of respondents: 23 %

The students' overall impression of the course is very positive, saying that they have learnt a lot, that the course was interesting, easy to follow and pedagogical. Most students experience the work pace of the course as just right, which is reflected in the hours per week they spend on the course. All respondents say that they spent 40 hours or less per week on the course. The students are very pleased with the course material, especially the video lectures and quizzes. However, some experienced the quizzes to be too easy.

The administration was also rated highly, although some wanted clearer instructions regarding the seminar groups. Some students wished for the final assignment and previous assignments as well as the seminar instructions to be available at an earlier stage of the course. Information about when assignments will be made available is also something the students would like. Regarding Blackboard some students would prefer an easier way to contact group members.

Finally, some students say that they have gained a new perspective on international law and feel lucky that they discovered this course.
